Due to typographical errors in the fourth example of a 2-credit response and in the second example of a 1-credit response, a revised rubric for these examples has been provided. In both instances, the correct denominator should be “29” rather than “19.” Please verify that all students’ responses to Question 38 have been scored in accordance with the corrected rubric below.
